I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

- Chair Maria Teresita Vilches-Landa called the meeting to order at 1:33PM.

II. ROLL CALL

- No formal roll call was conducted due to the virtual format. Members were requested to enter their names and agency affiliations into the chat for record-keeping purposes.

III. REVIEW OF AGENDA

- The agenda was reviewed without objections or proposed modifications from attendees.

IV. REVIEW OF MINUTES – Meeting of October 8, 2025

- The minutes from the October 8, 2025, meeting were reviewed. Approval was deferred to the next in-person meeting.

V. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- No public comments were received.

VI. COMMENTS FROM THE CHAIR

- Chair Vilches shared a video of the South Corridor BRT. This is the first all-electric BRT system in the country. She encouraged members to ride the 20 miles and experience BRT firsthand. Tours are being provided, and it is great to experience it.

VII. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. FY 2027-28 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)- Regional Coordination

- Andrew Uhlir (Palm Beach MPO) initiated discussion on upcoming UPWP development, including funding allocations for SERPM maintenance and SERPM 10 development.
- It was confirmed that FDOT District 4 will continue to fund SERPM maintenance

directly, eliminating the need for MPO transfers.

- MPO Members agreed to include remainder funding in FY27 for SERPM 10 development.
- Discussion also addressed timing of the next Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), expected to begin scoping in late 2026 for adoption in 2030.
- Members emphasized coordinating draft UPWP language across MPOs and vetting with FDOT and FHWA for consistency.
- Consensus: Continued coordination will occur ahead of UPWP adoption in spring 2026.

B. Regional Transportation Plan

1. Preparing for the 2055 RTP

- Members discussed scoping, consultant tasks, and development timelines.

2. Transition Plan

- The committee reviewed the timeline for transitioning administrative responsibilities and aligning regional tasks.

3. Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

- Members agreed to update the previous MOU and circulate a working draft aligned with UPWP and RTP schedules.

C. Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP) Agency Updates and Regional Section

- Agencies reviewed recent TRIP funding guidance. FDOT's allocation letters for FY2028–32 were acknowledged; members noted allocations are reduced compared with prior cycles. Discussion focused on identifying candidate projects and strategies to leverage available SU/TRIP funds. Agencies agreed to coordinate and produce a consolidated list of TRIP candidates ahead of the January/February schedule.

D. US-27 Freight Rail- Discussion

The committee discussed the status of US-27 freight-rail planning and stakeholder concerns. Key points:

- Prior corridor studies identified most necessary right-of-way, but funding and long-term operations remain open questions.

- FDOT's current posture (as reported) is to prioritize projects with defined funding and implementation strategies; the need for clarity on who would build and operate any rail investment was emphasized.
- Action proposed: prepare a letter and resolution options for SEFTC to consider (sendable, adoptable, or no action) so SEFTC can decide at its February meeting. RTTAC members agreed staff should draft that language for review in advance of the SEFTC decision.

E. 2026 RTTAC Membership- Update

- A Microsoft Forms link will be distributed to update all primary and secondary member contacts.

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS (no Discussion)

A. Public Participation Subcommittee

- No specific updates; regular reports to resume in upcoming sessions.

B. Modeling Subcommittee

- Next virtual workshop scheduled for December 1st, 2025.

C. TSM&O Subcommittee

- Meeting was held on October 23rd, 2025 and a presentation on the FIFA was provided. RTTAC members requested a future presentation from DTPW on FIFA preparations during the next RTTAC meeting for informational purposes as the traffic will impact the entire region. Jorge will follow up on this request.

IX. MEMBER COMMENTS

- The next meeting is scheduled for December 10th and will be a workshop. Next in person meeting will be January 7th at the Miami-Dade TPO office.
- The next SEFTC meeting is scheduled for February 20th, 2026, at the Palm Beach MPO.
