III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

- Motion made by Mr. Flavien to approve the agenda and seconded by Ms. Yesbeck
In a voice vote, the motion passes unanimously.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Meeting of April 30th, 2025

- Motion made by Mr. Uhlir to approve the minutes of April 30th, 2025, and seconded by Mr. Flavien. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.

V. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Chair Vilches-Landa opened the meeting for the reasonable opportunity to be heard and seeing no one appearing to speak, the public comment period was closed.

VI. COMMENTS FROM THE CHAIR

- Chair Vilches-Landa shared an update on the Tri-Rail Coastal Link, noting that Miami-Dade and Broward counties are coordinating to simultaneously open the Northeast Corridor commuter rail from Miami to Aventura and extend service into Broward County. Five new stations are planned to directly serve Wynwood, the Design District, Little Haiti, North Miami, and FIU's North Campus. The operating entity for the rail line is expected to be selected within four months. These efforts are also reflected in the 2050 RTP Executive Summary.

VII. ACTION ITEMS

A. Motion to Recommend the Southeast Florida Transportation Council (SEFTC) Approval the 2050 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)

- Jessica Josselyn of Kittelson & Associates presented the final 2050 RTP, noting that the plan reflects a two-year collaborative regional effort with input from all member agencies. Updates to memos and the Executive Summary incorporated recent comments, including terminology adjustments to align with federal requirements and improve clarity.

Discussion included:

- **Scenario Development:** All scenarios were completed, with qualitative and quantitative analysis provided. A minor model re-run will occur for consistency without impacting results.
- **Executive Summary and Website:** Members praised the design and accessibility. Requested edits include language adjustments to emphasize “flexibility within existing programs” and revising references to “new policies.”
- **Data and Outputs:** Jessica confirmed that regional network shapefiles will be shared and adjustments made to transit numbers in the modeling memo where inconsistencies were noted.

The RTP website is scheduled to launch by June 27, prior to scheduled SEFTC meeting.

- Motion: Motion to recommend SEFTC approve the 2050 RTP (including executive summary, technical reports, and website) was made by Mr. Francisco and seconded by Ms. Yesback. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Recommend Approval of the Southeast Florida Transportation Council (SEFTC) Agenda

- An amendment was recommended to include language specifying “Executive Summary, technical reports, and website.” Motion to approve the amended SEFTC agenda was made by Mr. Flavien and seconded by Mr. Francisco. The motion passed unanimously.

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS (No Discussion)

A. Public Participation Subcommittee

- The subcommittee has completed its primary tasks. A final social media campaign promoting the RTP completion is planned for August to coincide with the start of the school year.

B. Modeling Subcommittee

- Mr. Flavien reported that SERPM 9 was officially released on June 3, 2025, and is now available for download via Cube. FDOT Central Office will proceed with converting the model to Visum, with a July workshop scheduled (June session was canceled). Work on SERPM 10 will follow, utilizing Visum platform.

C. TSM&O Subcommittee

- Mr. Rosenberg reported that the next TSM&O Subcommittee meeting is scheduled for July 24, 2025, at the Broward MPO. The agenda is being finalized.

IX. MEMBER’S COMMENTS

- SEFTC meeting is scheduled for June 27, 2025, at 9:30 AM at Miami-Dade TPO.
- Chair Vilches-Landa suggested recessing RTTAC for July and August, with meetings resuming on September 10, 2025. Members agreed with this recommendation.
- Mr. Gies reported on discussions with FDOT District 4 and Broward County Transit regarding the express bus service between Broward and Miami-Dade counties. Funding gaps remain, and a future RTTAC presentation is recommended.

- Announcement: Mr. Gies will transition to new responsibilities under the UPWP. Mr. Chris Rosenberg will assume RTTAC duties.
