III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

- Motion made by Mr. Flavien to approve the agenda and seconded by Ms. Yesbeck
In a voice vote, the motion passes unanimously.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Meeting of April 30th, 2025

- Motion made by Mr. Uhlir to approve the minutes of April 30th, 2025, and seconded by Mr. Flavien. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.

V. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Chair Vilches-Landa opened the meeting for the reasonable opportunity to be heard and seeing no one appearing to speak, the public comment period was closed.

VI. COMMENTS FROM THE CHAIR

- Chair Vilches-Landa shared an update on the Tri-Rail Coastal Link, noting that Miami-Dade and Broward counties are coordinating to simultaneously open the Northeast Corridor commuter rail from Miami to Aventura and extend service into Broward County. Five new stations are planned to directly serve Wynwood, the Design District, Little Haiti, North Miami, and FIU's North Campus. The operating entity for the rail line is expected to be selected within four months. These efforts are also reflected in the 2050 RTP Executive Summary.

VII. ACTION ITEMS

A. Motion to Recommend the Southeast Florida Transportation Council (SEFTC) Approval the 2050 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)

- Jessica Josselyn of Kittelson & Associates presented the final 2050 RTP, noting that the plan reflects a two-year collaborative regional effort with input from all member agencies. Updates to memos and the Executive Summary incorporated recent comments, including terminology adjustments to align with federal requirements and improve clarity.

Discussion included:

- **Scenario Development:** All scenarios were completed, with qualitative and quantitative analysis provided. A minor model re-run will occur for consistency without impacting results.
- **Executive Summary and Website:** Members praised the design and accessibility. Requested edits include language adjustments to emphasize “flexibility within existing programs” and revising references to “new policies.”
- **Data and Outputs:** Jessica confirmed that regional network shapefiles will be shared and adjustments made to transit numbers in the modeling memo where inconsistencies were noted.

The RTP website is scheduled to launch by June 27, prior to scheduled SEFTC meeting.

- Motion: Motion to recommend SEFTC approve the 2050 RTP (including executive summary, technical reports, and website) was made by Mr. Francisco and seconded by Ms. Yesback. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Recommend Approval of the Southeast Florida Transportation Council (SEFTC) Agenda

- An amendment was recommended to include language specifying “Executive Summary, technical reports, and website.” Motion to approve the amended SEFTC agenda was made by Mr. Flavien and seconded by Mr. Francisco. The motion passed unanimously.

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS (No Discussion)

A. Public Participation Subcommittee

- The subcommittee has completed its primary tasks. A final social media campaign promoting the RTP completion is planned for August to coincide with the start of the school year.

B. Modeling Subcommittee

- Mr. Flavien reported that SERPM 9 was officially released on June 3, 2025, and is now available for download via Cube. FDOT Central Office will proceed with converting the model to Visum, with a July workshop scheduled (June session was canceled). Work on SERPM 10 will follow, utilizing Visum platform.

C. TSM&O Subcommittee

- Mr. Rosenberg reported that the next TSM&O Subcommittee meeting is scheduled for July 24, 2025, at the Broward MPO. The agenda is being finalized.

IX. MEMBER’S COMMENTS

- SEFTC meeting is scheduled for June 27, 2025, at 9:30 AM at Miami-Dade TPO.
- Chair Vilches-Landa suggested recessing RTTAC for July and August, with meetings resuming on September 10, 2025. Members agreed with this recommendation.
- Mr. Gies reported on discussions with FDOT District 4 and Broward County Transit regarding the express bus service between Broward and Miami-Dade counties. Funding gaps remain, and a future RTTAC presentation is recommended.

- Announcement: Mr. Gies will transition to new responsibilities under the UPWP. Mr. Chris Rosenberg will assume RTTAC duties.

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

- Chair Maria Teresita Vilches-Landa called the meeting to order at 1:33PM.

II. ROLL CALL

- No formal roll call was conducted due to the virtual format. Members were requested to enter their names and agency affiliations into the chat for record-keeping purposes.

III. REVIEW OF AGENDA

- The agenda was reviewed without objections or proposed modifications from attendees.

IV. REVIEW OF MINUTES – Meeting of June 11, 2025

- The minutes from the June 11, 2025 meeting were reviewed. Approval was deferred to the next in-person meeting.

V. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- No public comments were received.

VI. COMMENTS FROM THE CHAIR

- Chair Vilches highlighted the **launch of the SoFloGO regional transit app** on August 11, 2025. She congratulated the SFRTA, Broward MPO, and all regional transit partners for their collaboration in integrating Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Broward County Transit, and Palm Tran into a unified platform.

Lorraine Cargill (SFRTA) acknowledged the leadership of the Broward MPO in funding and advancing the project, as well as project manager Lee Taylor and supporting staff.

- Chair Vilches praised the app's real-time trip planning, mobile ticketing, and regional interoperability, noting its significance for unified regional mobility.

VII. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. FY 2027-28 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)- Regional Coordination

- Andrew Uhler (Palm Beach TPA) initiated discussion on upcoming UPWP development, including funding allocations for SERPM maintenance and SERPM 10 development.
- It was confirmed that FDOT District 4 will continue to fund SERPM maintenance directly, eliminating the need for MPO transfers.
- MPO Members agreed on including remainder funding in FY 2027 for SERPM 10 development.
- Discussion also addressed timing of the next Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), expected to begin scoping in late 2026 for adoption in 2030.
- Members emphasized coordinating draft UPWP language across MPOs and vetting with FDOT and FHWA for consistency.
- Consensus: Continued coordination will occur ahead of UPWP adoption in spring 2026.

B. Regional Transit App- SoFloGo Update

- Vince Sciallo (SFRTA) presented an overview of the newly launched SoFloGO app, highlighting:
 - **Trip Planning:** Multi-agency trip planning with real-time arrival information.
 - **Mobile Ticketing:** Unified payment platform supporting Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, BCT, and Palm Tran.
 - **Service Alerts:** Integrated notifications across participating systems.
- Promotional campaigns are underway through October, with a rotating marketing effort planned among agencies.
- Members commended the regional collaboration and noted the importance of continued promotion and user education.

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS (no Discussion)

A. Public Participation Subcommittee

- No specific updates; regular reports to resume in upcoming sessions.

B. Modeling Subcommittee

- Next virtual workshop scheduled for September 29, 2025.
- Consultant selection for SERPM 10 development is underway (within procurement cone of silence).

C. TSM&O Subcommittee

- The next TSM&O meeting is scheduled for October 2025.
- FDOT District 4 presented its draft TSM&O master plan at the most recent meeting.

IX. MEMBER COMMENTS

- Kent Walia (FDOT District 4) requested a consolidated list of RTTAC and SEFTC meeting dates for calendar planning. Staff agreed to distribute.
- The next RTTAC meeting is scheduled for October 8, 2025, at the Palm Beach TPA.
- The next SEFTC meeting is scheduled for October 17, 2025, at the Palm Beach TPA.

I. Call to Order

Chair Furr called the meeting to order at 9:31AM.

II. Roll Call

Mr. Moyse called the roll of SEFTC members. All members were present; the quorum was met.

III. Approval of Agenda

Motion made by Vice Chair Reed, seconded by Board member Diaz-Padron, to approve. In a voice vote, the **motion** passed unanimously.

IV. Approval of Minutes of May 16, 2025

Motion made by Vice Chair Reed, seconded by Board member Diaz-Padron, to approve. In a voice vote, the **motion** passed unanimously.

V. Public Comments

Chair Furr opened the meeting for treasonable opportunity to be heard and seeing no one appearing to speak, the public comment period was closed.

VI. Comments from the Chair

Chair Furr provided an update on regional transportation trends, highlighting positive ridership growth on Tri-Rail. He noted that in the first quarter of 2025, Tri-Rail experienced a 2% increase in ridership compared to the same period in 2024, a year in which the system had already reported full ridership recovery.

VII. ACTION ITEM

A. Adoption of the 2050 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) including the executive summary, technical reports, and website

Franchesca Taylor (Miami-Dade TPO) presented the final RTP materials, including the technical reports, executive summary, and official website (www.seftc.org/2050rtp).

- Chair Furr praised the team and requested additional copies of the Executive Summary.
- All members echoed the need for more copies for their respective boards and staff.

- Aileen Bouclé (Miami-Dade TPO) recognized staff from all three MPOs for their collaboration, noting that the 2045 RTP allocated 76% to roadway projects and 24% to mobility and transit projects.

Motion made by Vice Chair Reed, seconded by Board member Diaz-Padron, to approve. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.

VIII. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. US-27 Multi Modal Planning Study

Kent Jefferies of FDOT District 6 provided an update on the US-27 Multimodal Planning Study, stating that the Department is still waiting for the final budget and allocations to be approved by the Governor. He also indicated that the study still has not started and that once the department receives the final approved budget, they can begin the process of hiring a consultant to move forward with the study.

IX. ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Greg Stuart, Broward MPO, announced the Safe Street Summit will take place at the Broward County Convention Center February 24-27, 2026.

X. MOTION TO ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, the meeting was adjourned at 10:00AM.
